BACKGROUND	Should be consistent for each slide. Choose right background for dramatic impact on the focus and attention of audience.
VISUAL AND TEXT ELEMENTS	1. Use a font size of 34 to 36 for slide Titles. 2. Font size should be large enough to read. 3. Use font size atleast 20 for slide content. 4. Use the same font size for each slide, using a variety of font is distracting. 5. Use standard font such as Times New Roman or Arial. 6. Use clear simple words.
GRAPHS AND CHART ELEMENTS	Use graphs instead of charts and words for statistical data.
REVIEW	Abstract will be reviewed by the Scientific Committee on the basis of their relevance to the congress theme, methodological, appropriateness and clarity.
ACCEPTANCE / REJECTION RESULT	We will send the result to the e-mail address you provided.
SCHEDULES FOR ORAL PRESENTERS	1. Accepted oral presentations are scheduled for 45 minutes and 10 minutes for question and answers. One to two minutes per slide is recommended for time appropriation. 2. Time limits will be strictly enforced and will kindly asked to end the talk when speakers are approaching their time limit. 3. Check your presentation at least 2 hours prior to the start of your session by keeping in touch with the technician at the speaker lounge. This is to minimize problems on the day of your talk and to avoid losing speaking time due to technical challenges or problems. 4. Please show up at the scientific room 15 minutes prior to the beginning of your lecture and schedule with the projectionist that your presentation is available in the computer. 5. We also recommend bringing a copy of your presentation on a CD or USB flash drive in case your presentation has not been properly uploaded. 6. Please save the file as follows: Surname, name and hand it in a CD, DVD or a USB stick.
